

1. Ford F-series (896,764 sold)

Ford's F-series pickup finished the year as 2017's best-selling vehicle in about as shocking a Star Wars film performing well at the box office. With a lead of more than 300,000 units over the second-place Chevrolet Silverado, the F-series has now topped the year-end sales list for 41 years straight. Many of the sales come from fleets, and this number includes the [Super Duty lineup](#), but there's no questioning Ford's constantly evolving abilities to build solid pickups that Americans want. - Due to continuity of the new blocks of time, teachers should see an approximate increase of 'meat and potato time' in all areas (except ELA) by **800 minutes** or **19.512 days** of instructional time based compared to our current schedule. That is a **10.4%** increase in instructional time just by taking opening and closing from 10 days over two week period to five days over a two week period. Calculation are based on a total of 8 minutes per day being used for openings and closings.

 - COMPROMISES INTEGRITY OF PROGRAMS THAT CURRENTLY EXIST
 - QUARTER OR TRI-MESTER CLASSES
 - REDUCES WORLD LANG AND PHYS. ED. OPPORTUNITIES
